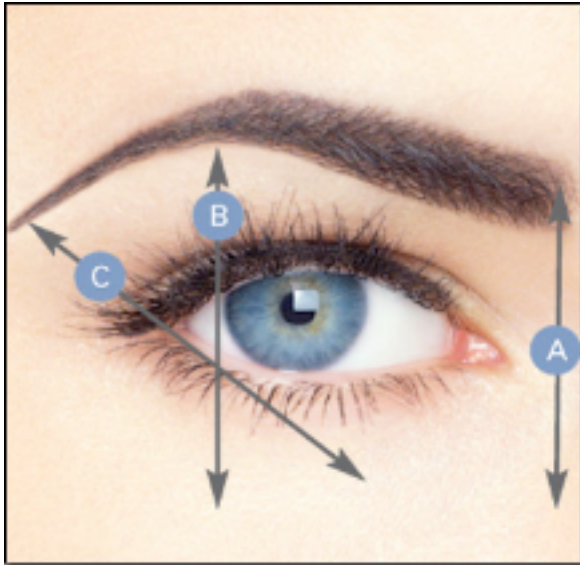


SHAPE YOUR EYEBROW



TIPS TO SUCCESS

1. LOOK AT YOUR BROW

Look in a mirror and determine the shape that you want for your eyebrows. Look at the photo and go through this slowly! As you look in a mirror, use a pencil or other straight object to hold in front of your eye like the arrows on the picture.

A. The inside edge of your brow should line up vertically with the outside top of your nose (nostril).

B. The high point of your brow arch should be in line with the outside edge of your iris, the colored part of the eye.

C. The outside edge of your brow should line up diagonally from the outside bottom of your nose (lower edge of nostril) following along the edge of eye.

2. TRIM FIRST

This should always be done before tweezing. Never trim the very last hairs from the end of the eyebrow. Brush your brow straight up with a brow brush or clean mascara wand, trim any hairs that are too long.

3. NOW TWEETZE

Be conservative and symmetrical: Tweeze a few hairs from the edge of one brow, then from the other. Avoid tweezing the top of the brow. If needed, professional waxing can remove those hairs. Don't tweeze white hairs in your brow just color them. Tweeze after your shower. It will be less painful.

4. FINISH UP

To tame your brow, spray a little hair spray on a clean mascara wand and comb through eye brows following shape of brow. Fill in and define shape with pencil or powder. Brows should be a shade darker than your hair color.
